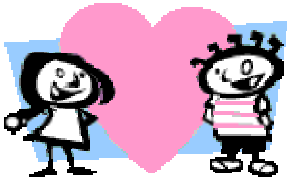

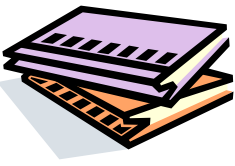

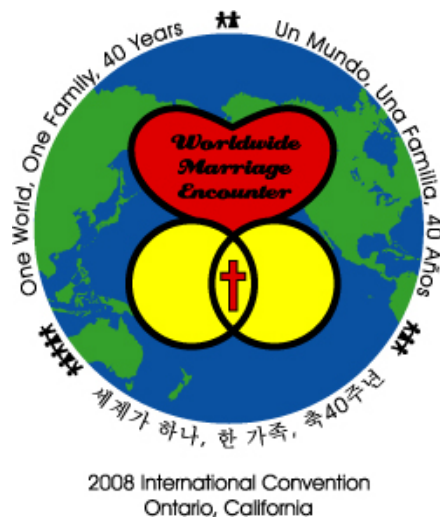

PRIESTHOOD SUNDAY

On October 28, 2007 we celebrated Priesthood Sunday in the entire Archdiocese of Kansas City in Kansas. This was the first event of which hopefully will be an annual celebration of the Sacrament of Holy Orders. It was an opportunity to both thank our priests for their dedication and service and to recognize the importance of their vocation.

The day was sponsored by the World Wide Marriage Encounter Movement and Serra International (A catholic group of men and women that support vocations). 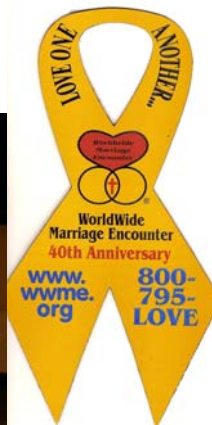

RECIPES:

Toasty Bacon Rollups Kyle and Denise Mead

Spread slices of wheat or white bread with soft Philadelphia cream cheese with chives. Remove crusts from bread. Slice each piece of bread in half. Roll up the bread and wrap a 1/3 of a piece of uncooked bacon (can be turkey bacon) around the bread roll and secure with a toothpick. Repeat with as many pieces of bread as you choose. Bake at 350 until toast is crispy-about 10-15 minutes. These are so simple, but absolutely yummy. (Highly addictive too.)

Strawberry Pie

4 cups of strawberries
1 pkg cook & serve vanilla pudding
1 pkg of sugar free Strawberry jello
2 cups water
1 8 oz tub of fat free Cool Whip

- ◆Slice strawberries and place in bottom of pie plate
- ◆Boil water and stir in vanilla pudding & strawberry jello
- ◆Pour over strawberries.
- ◆Let stand in refrigerator till firm. Top with Cool Whip

Pineapple Fluff

1 pkg cook & serve vanilla pudding
20 oz can crushed pineapple
1 pkg sugar free Orange jello
1 8 oz tub of fat free Cool Whip

- ◆Drain pineapple juice into measuring cup
- ◆Add water to 2 cups
- ◆Stir in pudding mix, bring to boil
- ◆Dissolve jello in mixture
- ◆Add pineapple & pour into pie tin
- ◆Chill 2-3 hours
- ◆Cover with Cool Whip and serve

Pope John Paul said "we should meditate on the mysteries of the rosary as we say it." These thoughts came to my mind. Mary & Carl Inzerillo

In the 1st Luminous Mystery "the Baptism of the Lord" Mathew (3 : 16-17) tells us "Then Jesus came out of the water, and behold, the heavens were opened for him, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and coming upon him. With that, a voice came from the heavens saying "THIS IS MY BELOVED SON, WITH WHOM I AM WELL PLEASED."

In the 4th Luminous Mystery "the Transfiguration" during the Transfiguration on Mount Tabor Mathew (17 : 5) tells us "While peter was speaking, behold, a bright cloud cast a shadow over them, then from the cloud came a voice that said," THIS IS MY BELOVED SON, WITH WHOM I AM WELL PLEASED; LISTEN TO HIM."

In the 5th Sorrowful Mystery "the Crucifixion" Mathew (27: 46 - 50) tells us "then toward mid-afternoon Jesus cried out in a loud tone "My God, My God, why have you forsaken me?" While people are speculating what this means, once again Jesus cried out in a loud voice, and then gave up his spirit."

In the 1st & 4th Luminous Mystery we see God the Father opening the heavens and announcing how pleased he is that Jesus- the Son of God- is doing his Fathers work. Yet, At the Crucifixion when Christ, the human, is in need of his fathers acclaim, God is silent. Or was he. Mathew goes on to tell us (51-54) "Suddenly the curtain of the sanctuary was torn in 2 from top to bottom, the earth quaked, boulders split, tombs opened. The centurions were terror-stricken at seeing all that was happing and said, "Clearly this was the Son of God!"

Today people proclaim God's message many ways. Do you proclaim the "word of Christ" by your words? Or do you "pass Christ love on to others by your deeds"? And if you do neither, why? As advent approaches you should look inside yourself. Are you a faith filled person? How do you show Christ to others?
